HALL OF FAME NOMINATION

Butte USBC

Instructions for completing the application:

- Complete the application as through as possible.
- Additional supporting information should be provided with the application.
 - The information on the application should be detail the information on the application
 i.e. dates, scores, position, etc.
 - The supporting information should detail items that are strong qualities that are not collected on the application.
 - Detail all information that supports application to hall of fame
 - Use as many pages as necessary
- Nominator should complete a detailed letter as to why they are nominating the individual
- Please provide a picture of the nominee

APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY December 31st. Applications shall be completed digitally. Applications may be submitted via email or by mail to the Butte USBC Hall of Fame Chairman.

Application Process: All applicants will be brought before the Butte USBC board. The Hall of Fame committee will recommend nominations to the board for consideration. The board will vote for the applicants at the spring meeting.

Application Requirements: The following lists of criteria will be used for selecting bowlers to be elected to the Butte USBC Hall of Fame.

- An applicant must meet all of the requirements listed in Part A.
- An applicant must have one strong qualification where they meet one or more of the requirements listed
- An application must show strength in one other category where they almost meet several of the listed requirements

A. Required Conditions for Application

- 1. Member of Butte USBC for 20 years, in any capacity
- 2. Minimum age of 50
- 3. Not currently suspended from national USBC (or any former bowling associations ABC, WIBC, etc.)

QUALIFICATIONS

- **1. Performance** To be considered for performance nomination a) and b) of this section need to be met.
 - a) The following are minimum performance standards to be accepted as a performance nomination.

- 1) At minimum bowled for 15 years in a sanctioned league, or
- 2) Male applications shall have maintained an average of 180 or more for a period of 10 years or more, or
- 3) Women applicants shall have maintained an average of 160 or more for a period of 10 years or more.
- b) The following are participations standards to be accepted as a performance nomination, one or more needs to be met to be considered. Participation may be in any event and in men, women, or mixed tournaments.
 - 1) Participated in a minimum of 15 City tournaments
 - 2) Participated in a minimum of 35 Local, City, State or The National Open Tournaments
 - 3) First place finish in Local, City, State, or The National Open Tournaments in any event
- c) The following are additional performance criteria that can be used to support the performance nomination. These are not required to be met.
 - 1) Other sanctioned tournaments bowled and placed in
 - 2) Demonstrated an amiable personality and good sportsmanship
 - 3) Received honors or recognition by the sport of bowling for competition, promotion of the sport of bowling, etc.
- 2. Administration To meet the requirements of administration nomination the applicant has to have held an office for a minimum of 15 years. If applicant holds two different offices during the same year, this will count as one year (i.e. league secretary and board member during the same time equals 1 year)
 - a) City league offices held
 - b) Butte USBC office held
 - c) Local Youth office held
 - d) Actively performed outstanding support and promotion of the sport of bowling (beyond Youth Bowling) i.e. helping with local tournaments, fund raisers, etc.
- **3.** Youth Bowling To meet the requirements of the Youth Bowling nomination the following criteria needs to be met.
 - a) Meet the requirements of Youth Office noted in Administration section plus B or C of this section, or
 - b) Served as a coach for the Youth Bowling program for 10 years or more, and
 - c) Have performed outstanding service to the promotion and support of Youth Bowling
