The Butte USBC city bowling tournaments were held on the last two weekends of January at the Star Lanes. The tournament consisted of the City Open Tournament and the Women's City Singles Tournament.

This year's open championship tournament had 55 teams, 67 doubles, and 134 singles. This was divided into 33 bowlers in division 1(average 199 and up), 55 bowlers in division 2 (average 172 – 198), and 73 bowlers in division 3 (average 171 and under) for a total of 161 bowlers. The women's City singles consisted of 28 bowlers consisting of 5 bowlers in division 1 (average 160+) and 23 bowlers in division 2 (159 and less).
