The Montana Bowling Proprietors Scholarship will be available for a period of 1 year after high school graduation. An extension beyond one year may be granted, but must be requested before July 1st of the year following graduation.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered, all candidates MUST:

1. Be a graduating senior.
2. Be a current member of a sanctioned USBC league in a Montana Bowling Proprietors Association member center (21 game minimum) and be in good standing for the current season. **Copies of most current League Standing sheets are required.**
3. Have unimpaired amateur standing in all athletic participation.
4. NOT bowled or participated in MUSBC Adult leagues or tournaments, jackpots, Monte Carlo's, etc.
EXCEPTION: It is acceptable to bowl in an adult singles league as long as any prize money is sent to SMART.
5. Include SAT/ACT test results if available in Part III of the application.
6. Send two (2) sets of the completed application and requested attachments NO LATER THAN MARCH 1.
Note: Applications postmarked after March 1 will not be accepted!!!
7. Attend a college, university, vocational-technical school or other accredited school of higher learning.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Each Candidate will:

1. Give Part II to their Coach and ask that he/she complete the form and return it to them.
2. Give Part III to a school Teacher or Counselor and request that they complete the form and return it.
3. Complete Part I, page 1 and 2, and have your Coach sign the completed form.
4. Obtain the completed forms from their Coach and Teacher/Counselor early enough to allow time to mail the application.
5. Make two (2) copies of each page of the completed scholarship application (Part 1, page 1 & 2, Part II, and Part III) and any additional information provided by their coach and/or teacher.
6. Submit the original and one (1) copy of the completed application to the Executive Director of the MBPA listed below, making sure your application is postmarked no later than March 1. Keep one (1) copy for yourself.
